

Rotary Club Luxembourg Hearts (English) to be Chartered



The first and only English-speaking Rotary Club in Luxembourg, focusing on international professionals, is being chartered on 4 October in the Grand Duchy.

The 20 founding members represent 12 different nationalities, with an average age of 35 and a 40-60 female-male split.

Their aim is to engage in hands-on social projects nationally and internationally. Already, in the run-up to the creation of the club its members have been active on various service projects:

- Hands-on support to the Croix-Rouge with their winter soup kitchen (Wanteraktioun) and for "Foyer Norbert Ensch" (Foster care children centre)
- Fundraising for the new English Kanner-Jugendtelefon (now in the planning stage)

The project that gave the club its name and that it will further pursue is Rotaract Hearts in South Africa (fundraising and renovating an orphanage for deaf-mute children) in which two of its founding members have participated.
